Compete for Bragging Rights in the Wildest & Wackiest Cardboard Boat Regatta Ever!

You'll need a captain, crew, and a hand built cardboard boat, one that hopefully will float.

All boats need to be completed prior to race day and delivered to the Fireside Park located on the Mill Pond portion of Spirit Lake across from the public boat launch by 9:00 am on the 22nd of May and will be on display for all to see and judged by spectators for the coveted **"Friggin' Awesome Award"** prior to racing that begins at 12:00 pm. The race will take place on a designated course set up on the Mill Pond along the shore of Fireside Park. There will be multiple groups of boats (*based on Class and Category*) racing around the course, trying to NOT TO SINK, and trying to cross the finish line in the fastest time. The fastest times (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place) in each class and category will win the prestigious **"Torpedo Award"**. The team with the most Team Spirit will win the **"Spirit Award"** and the Most Spectacular Sinking will win the infamous **"Titanic Award"**.

2 Classes - Limited and Unlimited

- 3 Categories**
- **Corporate:** Business Sponsored Teams (*2-4 people per Team*)
 - **Youth and School:** Sponsored Teams: 8-17 years old (*2-4 people per Team*)
 - **Adult:** Team: 16 years old or older (*2 people per boat*)

Trophy Plaques Awarded for Each Category:

1. **Torpedo Award** 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, - Best time around the course (*still floating under paddle power*)
2. **Spirit Award** – for best team spirit
3. **Friggin' Awesome Award** – best overall look and design
4. **Titanic Award** – Most spectacular sinking (*must salvage your boat remains*)

Limited Class Design Challenge Rules of the Boat Design - \$120.00 entry fee

Open to Corporate Sponsored Teams, Individual Adult and Youth Teams wanting to challenge others by showing what they can do using the same supplied materials as other entries.

Entry Fee includes:

- **2 - 4' X 8' Sheets of Double Fluted Cardboard and 5 Rolls of Duct Tape**
- **2 Commemorative T-shirts per Team** (*Additional T-Shirts are available for \$10.00 ea.*)
- **Participation Certificates for each Team Member** (*Max 4*)
- **Award Plaque for Winning Entry**

1. As part of your "Limited Class" entry fee each team will receive the same building materials.

- **2 - 4' X 8' Sheets of double fluted corrugated cardboard and 5 rolls duct tape.**

The boat must be made of nothing more than supplied materials, plus your own glue, chalk and any one-part substance water proofing material, such as varnish or latex paint. (*A two-part substance would include those that require the addition of a catalyst or hardener... This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes.*) Plastic liners such as tarps or trash bags are not allowed.

2. The boat must hold at least two people.
3. Boats can be a maximum width of 60" (5 ft.) and a maximum length of 84" (7ft)
4. Boats must be propelled by paddle power ONLY. NO Motors!
5. NO surfboard style boat is allowed.
6. Unique boat designs and creativity is encouraged.
7. Crew costumes are encouraged.
8. Your boat must be free of sharp edges, pointy objects or anything else that could cause injuries

Unlimited Class "Go Nuts" Challenge Rules of the Boat Design \$60.00 entry fee

Open to Corporate Sponsored Teams, Individual Adult and Youth Teams wanting create a unique and spectacular entry limited only by your imagination

Entry Fee includes:

- **2 Commemorative T-shirts per Team** (*Additional T-Shirts are available for \$10.00 ea.*)
- **Participation Certificates for each Team Member** (*Max 4*)
- **Award Plaque for Winning Entry**

1. In the "Unlimited Class" each team will source their own boat building materials. The Boat must be made of only cardboard and duct tape (NOT cardboard and wood or cardboard and metal or use metal screws for holding), plus glue, chalk and any one-part substance water proofing material, such as varnish or latex paint. (*A two-part substance would include those that require the addition of a catalyst or hardener... This eliminates epoxy glue, fiberglass, and certain varnishes.*) Plastic liners such as tarps or trash bags are not allowed.

3. The boat must hold at least two people or more.
4. Boats size is Unlimited
5. Boats must be propelled by paddle power ONLY.
6. NO surfboard style boat is allowed.
7. Unique boat designs and creativity is encouraged.
8. Crew costumes are encouraged.
8. Your boat must be free of sharp edges, pointy objects or anything else that could cause injuries

Remember... All entries must be made of nothing but cardboard and duct tape - NOT cardboard and wood or cardboard and metal or use metal screws for holding.

If the judge deems it necessary, your entry must pass the dreaded "Ice Pick Test" & Metal Detector Test!! This verifies that the boat is constructed of only cardboard with no wood or metal.

Registration Deadline: March, 15, 2021

Once we receive your completed registration and payment we will email you confirmation and an Entry Number,

This assigned number must be prominently displayed on your boat entry and visible to the judges.

(If you are in the **Limited Class** we will coordinate a time and place for you to pick up you building materials kit.
